## 1. Programme structure

- (a) The programme is available for study in both full-time and part-time modes. The part-time route will be decided in consultation with the Degree Programme Director.
- (b) The period of study for full-time mode shall be one year starting in September. The period of study for part-time mode shall normally be two years starting in September.
- (c) By agreement with the Degree Programme Director, students may take advantage of the School's exchange agreement with the University of Michigan, USA.
- (d) The programme comprises modules to a credit value of 180 (and at least 150 credits of which must be at level 7), with a maximum of 70 credits in Semesters 1 or 2.
- (e) All candidates shall take the following compulsory modules:
