1. Programme structure

- (a) The programme is available for study in both full-time and part-time modes.
- (b) The period of study for full-time mode shall be one year starting in September. The period of study for part-time mode shall normally be two years starting in September. The part-time route will be agreed between the student and the Degree Programme Director.
- (c) The programme comprises modules to a credit value of 180.
- (d) All candidates following the ESRC Nine DTP 1+3 programme shall take the following compulsory modules:
