- (f) Modules to the value of 20 credits can be taken from level 7 modules in other Schools in substitution for modules in the above list, with the Degree Programme Director's approval. A candidate's selection shall, in all cases, be subject to the approval of the Degree Programme Director.
- (g) An alternative module can be taken with the Degree Programme Director's approval in place of either HSS8001 (Thinking About Research), HSS8004 (Introduction to Qualitative Methods) or HSS8005 (Quantitate Analysis), where a student can demonstrate that completion of postgraduate level training in the subject matter of these modules has already taken place. LAW8152 (Applied Research Methods in Law) shall however be compulsory for all students registered for the LLM Law and Society (Research).
- (h) A part-time student shall take such modules in each year of registration as shall be determined by the Degree Programme Director provided that, at the completion of year 2, the full programme has been taken. A part time student shall normally take modules to the value of 90 credits in year 1 and modules to the value of 90 credits (including Law 8099 Dissertation) in year 2.

2. Assessment methods
