Notes

- (i) These programme regulations should be read in conjunction with the University's Taught Programme Regulations.
- (ii) A core module is a module which a student must pass.
- (iii) A compulsory module is a module which a student is required to study.
- (iv) All modules are delivered in Linear mode unless stated otherwise as Block, eLearning or distance learning.

1. Programme Structure

- (a) The programme is available for part-time study and it is specifically designed to be undertaken by students who work in an educational context.
- (b) The period of study for part-time mode shall normally be 9 months starting in September or January.
- (c) The programme comprises taught modules to a credit value of 60 credits.
- (d) Candidates shall follow one of the three modular routes as described below. Candidates on route 1 shall engage with modules described in (g) and (h). The School of Education, Communication and Language Sciences is one of ten partners of the North East Teaching Schools Partnership (NETSP) and therefore, the licence holder of the National Leadership Curriculum for Middle Leadership (NPQML), Senior Leadership (NPQSL) and Headship (NPQH) programmes. Candidates who have successfully completed the NPQML will follow the route described in (h) and those who have successfully completed the NPQSL will follow the route described in (i). Candidates who are enrolled or have successfully completed the reformed National Professional Qualifications for professional development of teachers and school leaders will follow the route described in (k).
- (e) To be eligible for modules EDU8900, EDU8901 and EDU8902, all students must satisfy the recruitment criteria with the North East Teaching Schools Partnership. To be eligible for modules EDU8907 and EDU9808, all students must satisfy the recruitment criteria set out by the Department of Education (DfE).
- (f) Modules EDU8900, EDU8901 and EDU8902 can be used towards the PG Certificate in Educational Leadership. Alternatively, students already registered for a Postgraduate Certificate in Educational Leadership, MEd (Practitioner Enquiry) or MEd (Practitioner Enquiry) Leadership can apply for these modules.
- (g) All candidates shall take the following compulsory modules totalling 40 credits:
