- (b) (3544F) PG Diploma in Landscape Design Studies (if they have successfully passed 120 credits of taught modules);
- (c) (5880F) Master of Landscape Studies (where students have failed up to 20 credits of the 300 core modules).

## 4. Exit Awards for students who start the programme before academic year 2024/25.

In the case of students who have not demonstrated the potential to succeed on the full programme, or who choose not to continue on the full programme at the end of 24 months, or where the progress of the student

is deemed unsatisfactory at subsequent stages, they may be considered for the award of the following unaccredited programmes:

- (a) (3184F) PG Certificate in Landscape Design Studies (if they have successfully passed 60 credits of taught modules),
- (b) (3544F) PG Diploma in Landscape Design Studies (if they have successfully passed 120 credits of taught modules);
- (c) (5880F) Master of Landscape Studies (where students have failed up to 20 credits of core modules).
