- (iv) *A compulsory module is a module which a student is required to study.*
- (v) *All modules are delivered in Linear mode unless stated otherwise as Block, eLearning or distance learning.*

1. Programme Structure

- (a) The programme is available for study in full-time mode only. All modules are delivered in Linear Mode.
- (b) The period of study for full-time mode shall be 1 year starting in September.
- (c) The programme comprises modules to a credit value of **180**.
- (d) All candidates shall take the following compulsory modules (**100** credits):

2. Semester of Exchange

- a. Candidates who have successfully passed all taught elements of Year 1 at the first or second attempt may take part in a semester of study abroad at one of the School's exchange partner institutions. Such candidates shall transfer to (5500F) MSc Sustainability Management (with Study Abroad).
- b. Permission to undertake the semester of exchange is subject to the approval of the Degree Programme Director. It is the responsibility of the individual students to make sure they meet the visa requirements of the country in which they plan to undertake a period of study. Travel and study abroad will be guided by the institutional policy and governmental policy at the time.
- c. International students undertaking this option must be aware that the University will withdraw UK student (Tier 4) visas for the time spent overseas.
- d. During the period of study abroad, students are required to take the following module:

Upon successful completion of the programme, the degree title awarded will be (5499F) MSc Sustainability Management. Candidates who choose to take part in the Study Abroad shall be transferred onto the 18-month version of the programme and graduate with (5500F) MSc Sustainability Management (with Study Abroad).
