- (iv) *A compulsory module is a module which a student is required to study.*
- (v) *All modules are delivered in Linear mode unless stated otherwise as Block, eLearning or distance learning.*

1. Programme Structure

- (a) The programme is available for study in full-time and part-time modes.
- (b) The full-time period of study for candidates who enter the programme in September shall be 1 year. The equivalent part-time period of study shall normally be 2 years.
- (c) The full-time period of study for candidates who enter the programme in January shall be 18 months. The equivalent part-time period of study shall normally be 2 years.
- (d) The programme comprises modules to a credit value of 180.
- (e) All candidates shall take the following compulsory modules:
