- (iii) A compulsory module is a module which a student is required to study.
- (iv) All modules are delivered in Linear mode unless stated otherwise as Block, eLearning or distance learning.

1. Programme Structure

- (a) The programme is available for part-time study and it is specifically designed to be undertaken by students who work in an educational context.
- (b) The period of study for part-time mode shall normally be 9 months starting in September or January.
- (c) The programme comprises taught modules to a credit value of 60 credits.
- (d) Candidates shall follow one of the three modular routes as described below. Candidates on route 1 shall engage with modules described in (g) and (h). The School of Education, Communication and Language Sciences has been offering, through partnership, various iterations of the suite National Professional Qualifications (NPQs). Candidates who have successfully completed one of these qualifications will be able to follow a specific route depending on the iteration of their as outlined in (h) to (j).
- (e) To be eligible for modules EDU8900, EDU8901 and EDU8902, EDU8904, EDU8905 and EDU8906 all students must satisfy the recruitment criteria with the North East Teaching Schools Partnership (NETSP). To be eligible for modules EDU8907 and EDU8908, all students must satisfy the recruitment criteria set out by the Department of Education (DfE).
- (f) Modules EDU8900, EDU8901, EDU8902, EDU8904, EDU8905 and EDU8906 can be used towards the PG Certificate in Educational Leadership. Alternatively, students already registered for a Postgraduate Certificate in Educational Leadership, MEd (Practitioner Enquiry) or MEd (Practitioner Enquiry) Leadership can apply for these modules.
- (g) All candidates shall take the following compulsory modules totalling 40 credits:
