

Programme Regulations: 2025/26

Programme Title: Postgraduate Certificate in Dental Education – 3534P

Notes

- (i) *These programme regulations should be read in conjunction with the University's Taught Programme Regulations.*
- (ii) *A core module for learning outcomes is a module which a student must pass.*
- (iii) *A core module for PSRB accreditation is a module a student is required to obtain accreditation.*
- (iv) *A compulsory module is a module which a student is required to study.*
- (v) *All modules are delivered in Linear mode unless stated otherwise as Block, eLearning or distance learning.*

1. Programme Structure

- (a) The programme is available for study in part-time mode only and delivered by distance eLearning with the exception of DEC8000 which is delivered by blended learning.
- (b) The period of study for part-time mode shall normally be one year starting in September.
- (c) The programme comprises modules to a credit value of 60.
- (d) All candidates shall take the following compulsory modules:
