- (iv) *All modules are delivered in Linear mode unless stated otherwise as Block, eLearning or distance learning.*

1. Programme structure

- (a) The programmes are available for study in both full-time and part-time (excluding Language Acquisition Research) modes.
- (b) The period of study for full-time mode shall be 1 year for Masters and eight months for Diploma starting in September. The period of study for part-time mode shall normally be 2 years starting in September. The Language Acquisition Research Pathway is not offered in part-time mode.
- (c) The programme comprises 2 taught Pathways (English Language Taught Pathway or English Acquisition Taught Pathway) and 1 Language Acquisition Research Pathway (the latter available to NINE-DTP students only); It comprises modules to a credit value of 180.
- (d) The dissertation must be written according to the pathway the student is following; likewise, dissertation supervisor choice must be in accordance with the pathway.
