- (ii) All optional modules are offered subject to the constraints of the timetable and to any restrictions on the number of candidates who may be taught on a particular module. Not all modules may be offered in all years, and they are listed subject to availability.
- (iii) Unless otherwise stated under 'Type', modules are not core.
- (iv) A compulsory module is a module which a candidate is required to study.
- (v) A core module is a module which a candidate must pass, and in which a fail mark may neither be carried nor compensated; such modules are designated by the Board of Studies as essential for progression to a further stage of the programme or for study in a further module.
- (vi) All modules are delivered in Linear mode unless stated otherwise as Block, eLearning or distance learning.
- (vii) Each Stage is made up of 120 credits. Candidates must ensure they choose a 60/60, 50/70 or 70/50 split of credits per semester.

General Principles

- 1. Candidates must take Spanish and Portuguese all the way through.
- 2. The choice of all modules is subject to any pre-requisites.
- 3. Candidates are only permitted to take 20 credits of Level 4 modules in Stage 2 and 20 credits of Level 5 modules in Final year.
- 4. Modules taken at Stage 1 cannot be repeated at Stage 2. Modules taken at Stage 2 cannot be repeated at Final Stage.

Candidates have the option to complete a Year Abroad between Stage 2 and final year. This decision is confirmed with School of Modern Languages during Stage 2. Candidates who opt not to take a Year Abroad can choose one of the following options:

- 1. Transfer to 1424U BA (Hons) Spanish, Portuguese and Latin American Studies (3-year programme) after completing Stage 2.
- 2. Transfer to 1919U BA (Hons) Spanish, Portuguese and Latin American Studies with Placement Year after completing Stage 2.

The Degree Programme Director will approve the transfer in each case.

- (a) Candidates can opt to take a Year Abroad, between Stage 2 and Stage 4 (final year), in an approved Spanish- and/or Portuguese-speaking country, either pursuing a course of study at a University or other comparable institution, or working as a language teaching assistant in schools under the auspices of the British Council, or undertaking an approved work placement.

Optional Placement Year

- (d) Candidates wishing to take a placement with an approved organisation will transfer to 1919U BA (Hons) Spanish, Portuguese and Latin American Studies with Placement Year. Permission to undertake a placement is subject to the approval of the Degree Programme Director. Candidates who are required to re-sit their Stage 2 assessment must delay the start of their placement until they have done so. Candidates who fail Stage 2 may not complete a placement year.
- (e) The placement must be based in the UK or can be the candidate's home country if they are not from the UK.

5. Assessment methods

Details of the assessment pattern for each module are explained in the module outline. A variety of methods are used: oral assessment; essays; unseen written examinations; in-course assessed work; on-line assessments; dissertation/T&I project. Candidates may be awarded a Distinction in Spoken Spanish or Spoken Portuguese as a result of performance in the oral examination at Level D (in Spanish) or the oral examination at Level C (in Portuguese), respectively.

6. Degree classification

RT47 [4-year programme]: Candidates will be assessed for degree classification on the basis of results achieved in 260 credits across Stages 2, 3, and 4. At stages 2 and 4, Candidates must obtain marks for 120 credits; in Stage 3 (the intercalating year), 120 credits must be studied and passed, but only the mark gained for the 20-credit modules (SML3006, SML3007, SML3008, SML3009 or SML3010) will count towards the degree. Modules taken at Stages 2 and 3 will be single-weighted and modules obtained at Stage 4 will be double-weighted. Stage 2 counts 28.54%, Stage 3 4.76% and Stage 4 66.7% towards the Final Degree Classification.

1424U [3-year programme]: Candidates will be assessed for degree classification on the basis of results achieved in 240 credits across Stages 2 and 3 (final year). Candidates must obtain marks in 120 credits in each of these Stages. Modules taken at Stage 2 will be single-weighted and modules obtained in Stage 3 (final year) will be double-weighted. Stage 2 counts 33.3% and Stage 3 (final year) 66.7% towards the Final Degree Classification.

1919U [4-year with Placement]: Candidates will be assessed for degree classification on the basis of results achieved in 240 credits across Stages 2 and 3 (final year). Candidates must obtain marks in 120 credits in each of these Stages. Modules taken at Stage 2 will be single-weighted and modules obtained at Stage 3 (final year) will be double-weighted. Stage 2 counts 33.3% and Stage 3 (final year) 66.7% towards the Final Degree Classification. The placement year is assessed on a pass/fail basis but does not contribute to the degree classification.

7. Programme Transfer

Any candidate who chooses to drop Portuguese will be transferred to T901 Modern Languages/1420U Modern Languages (3-Year Programme) or 1919U Modern Languages with Placement Year as appropriate. It is not possible to drop Spanish and continue studying a degree programme in the School of Modern Languages.
