#### *Notes*

- (i) These programme regulations should be read in conjunction with the University's Undergraduate Progress Regulations and Examination Conventions.*
- (ii) All optional modules are offered subject to the constraints of the timetable and to any restrictions on the number of candidates who may be taught on a particular module. Not all modules may be offered in all years and they are listed subject to availability.*
- (iii) Unless otherwise stated under 'Type', modules are not core.*
- (iv) A compulsory module is a module which a candidate is required to study.*
- (v) A core module is a module which a candidate must pass, and in which a fail mark may neither be carried nor compensated; such modules are designated by the Board of Studies as essential for progression to a further stage of the programme or for study in a further module. A final stage module cannot be deemed to be core.*
- (vi) All modules are delivered in Linear mode unless stated otherwise as Block, eLearning or distance learning.*
- (vii) Each Stage is made up of 120 credits. Candidates must ensure they choose a 60/60, 50/70 or 70/50 split of credits per semester.*

#### **General Principles**

1. Candidates shall choose either Chinese or Japanese at Stage 1, and must study the same language in subsequent Stages, unless they choose not to complete an optional intercalating year abroad, and choose not to study Chinese or Japanese language in final year. These candidates will be awarded the degree title of BA (Hons) East Asian Studies.
2. Candidates must choose a minimum of 20 credits of an option pertaining to the relevant language, e.g. CHN for Chinese and JPN for Japanese, in each Stage.
3. In order to proceed to the optional intercalating year of study, candidates must have satisfied the Board of Examiners in the programme requirements at Stage 2 and the entry requirements of the host country.
4. In all cases the specific choice of institution for the intercalating year of study for those on TT12 will be subject to the approval of the Degree Programme Director. In certain

circumstances the requirements expressed in 1(c) may be waived or varied by the Degree Programme Director.

5. Candidates on TT12 are required to conform to, and sign their acceptance of, an explicit code of conduct which requires them to abide by the regulations of the host institution, to attend classes regularly and to sit local examinations as required during the intercalating year of study. In the case of non-compliance with this, there is provision for the recall of candidates in exceptional circumstances by the Degree Programme Director.
6. The choice of all modules is subject to any pre-requisites.
7. Candidates are only permitted to take 20 credits of Level 4 modules in Stage 2 and 20 credits of Level 5 modules in Final year.
8. Modules taken at Stage 1 cannot be repeated at Stage 2. Modules taken at Stage 2 cannot be repeated at Final Stage.
9. High-achieving candidates who have taken a Level B language at Stage 2 may be able to enter Level D of that language at final year with permission of the DPD. The relevant language module leader will make the initial assessment.

Non-attendance at the relevant briefings for this module may mean that candidates could be prevented from starting the Intercalating Year.

Candidates have the option to complete a Year Abroad between Stage 2 and final year. This decision is confirmed with School of Modern Languages during Stage 2. Candidates who opt not to take a Year Abroad can choose one of the following options:

1. Transfer to 1425U BA (Hons) Chinese/Japanese Studies (3-year programme) after completing Stage 2.
2. Transfer to 1922U BA (Hons) Chinese/Japanese Studies with Placement Year after completing Stage 2.
3. Transfer to 1923U BA (Hons) East Asian Studies (3-year programme) after completing Stage 2 if they choose not to continue studying Chinese/Japanese language in final year.
4. Transfer to 1924U BA (Hons) East Asian Studies with Placement Year after completing Stage 2 if they choose not to continue studying Chinese/Japanese language in final year.

The Degree Programme Director will approve this transfer in each case.

## Section 2 – Optional Intercalating Year Abroad/Placement Year

### Optional Intercalating Year Abroad

- (a) Candidates can opt to take a Year Abroad between Stage 2 and Stage 4 (final year). The year abroad must be spent pursuing a course of study at a university or other comparable institution in China or Japan as appropriate.
- (b) Candidates wishing to study Chinese or Japanese at Stage 4 opting for a Year Abroad are required to spend either one semester or a complete academic year between Stage 2 and Stage 4 (final year) pursuing courses of study at a university or comparable institution in the relevant country. An approved work placement is not an option for China or Japan.
- (c) All candidates shall take the following compulsory modules:

### Optional Placement Year

- (d) Candidates wishing to take a placement with an approved organisation will transfer to 1922U BA (Hons) Chinese/Japanese Studies with Placement Year. Candidates wishing to take a placement with an approved organisation but do not want to continue studying Chinese or Japanese will transfer to 1924U BA (Hons) East Asian Studies with Placement Year. Permission to undertake a placement is subject to the approval of the Degree Programme Director. Candidates who are required to re-sit their Stage 2 assessment must delay the start of their placement until they have done so. Candidates who fail Stage 2 may not complete a placement year.
- (e) The placement must be based in the UK or can be the candidate's home country if they are not from the UK.
- (f) During their placement year, candidates are required to take the following module:

<b>Section 3 – Other information for all candidates</b>
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### 5. Assessment Methods

A range of assessment methods will be used, including the following: unseen written examination; critical commentary on unseen texts; in-course assessed essay and/or project; extended essay; assessed oral presentation; dissertation/T&I project; continuous assessment test, portfolio of written work and oral/aural examination (for language modules). Details of the method of assessment for each module are published in the relevant School. Candidates may be awarded a Distinction as a result in their performance in the oral examination at Level C or D Chinese or Japanese in final year.

### 6. Degree classification

**TT12 [4-year programme]:** Candidates will be assessed for degree classification on the basis of results achieved in 260 credits across Stages 2, 3, and 4. In Stages 2 and 4, candidates must obtain marks for 120 credits; in Stage 3 (the intercalating year), 120 credits must be studied and passed, but only the mark gained for SML3006 will count towards the degree. Modules taken at Stages 2 and 3 will be single-weighted and modules obtained in Stage 4 will be double-weighted. Stage 2 counts 28.54%, Stage 3 4.76% and Stage 4 66.7% towards the Final Degree Classification.

**1425U [Chinese/Japanese Studies] and 1923U [East Asian Studies] [3-year programmes]:** Candidates will be assessed for degree classification on the basis of results achieved in 240 credits across Stages 2 and 3 (final year). Candidates must obtain marks in 120 credits in each of these Stages. Modules taken at Stage 2 will be single-weighted and modules obtained in Stage 3 (final year) will be double-weighted. Stage 2 counts 33.3% and Stage 3 (final year) 66.7% towards the Final Degree Classification.

**1922U [Chinese/Japanese Studies with Placement Year] and 1924U [East Asian Studies with Placement Year] [4-year with Placement]:** Candidates will be assessed for degree classification on the basis of results achieved in 240 credits across Stages 2 and 3 (final year). Candidates must obtain marks in 120 credits in each of these Stages. Modules taken at Stage 2 will be single-weighted and modules obtained in Stage 3 (final year) will be double-weighted. Stage 2 counts 33.3% and Stage 3 (final year) 66.7% towards the Final Degree Classification. The placement year is assessed on a pass/fail basis but does not contribute to the degree classification.
